

## **County Councillors Report- December 2018**

### **Rubbish**

A clean up was arranged prior to Christmas at a location close to the Town Centre. This was actioned on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2019. The landlord is to be contacted to point between the stones and ensure the area is kept free of rodent habitats.

### **Town of culture 2019**

Launch event at Canolfan Hywel Dda to include a representative from each Community venue and from voluntary community groups who have assisted in support of events in the past along with school representatives. Lord Dafydd Elis Thomas, Minister for Culture, is the guest and the Chief Executive and Chairman of the County Council will attend. The Mayor has agreed to present a gift to the Minister on behalf of the Town.

### **Leader Projects**

Attended a meeting re Town Wifi review and to ensure WTC Clerk/Cllrs will receive data and data training. An unusual peak was noted on a Tuesday but this is likely to be related to the Livestock Mart. The Christmas event December data is not yet available.

The Officers are prepared to assist the WTC with a formal neighbourhood plan and have funding for a variety of support. I have agreed (on Cllrs' behalf) that Whitland and WTCV are very keen to have this. An example for the feasibility study (feasibility funded) is the inclusion of the railway sidings and footpath/cycle path which link to the Cardi Bah route already in the LDP (Local Development Plan).

### **Dementia Friendly Communities Launch**

This is on 1<sup>st</sup> February at Ysgol Griffith Jones and includes Whitland St Clears and Laugharne. It is noted there is an international match at 9pm but the event is due to be completed at 8.30pm. If Cllrs wish to attend please let the Clerk know. The Mayor is aware already.
